Dear Principal,

This is to inform you that the Arts Council of Pointe Coupee has established a **Prof Jewell Teacher Grant** in memory of **Ellet Benjamin Jewell**, a native of Pointe Coupee and a well-known educator in the parish from 1912 until 1945. The Arts Council will award two grants worth \$250 each to regular classroom teachers in Pointe Coupee Parish to purchase materials for a classroom project in any arts related discipline.

To qualify, teachers must submit a letter describing the project to the Arts Council of Pointe Coupee by **Friday, October 19, 2018**. The letter should address the following:

- Identification of the arts related project
- A detailed description of the project with goals and objectives
- Procedure to be followed
- Anticipated benefits to the student
- List of materials needed and cost
- Length of the project
- Role of the teacher as the facilitator
- Method of evaluation
- Culminating activity(s)
- Can the project be used year after year?
