



11th Treasures Art Exhibit Submission Guidelines

Sponsored by the Arts Council of Pointe Coupee

The Treasures of Pointe Coupee Art Exhibit is designed to celebrate and showcase local and regional artists. It also offers an exceptional art experience to the public at large. A "Best in Show" and other ribbons are presented. The exhibit opens with a reception for participating artists and the community. It continues for two weekends with additional arts-related activities including adult and youth art workshops, Arts Market, Conversations with the Artist programs, Treasure Hunt activity, Petite Gallerie display, etc. Details of these activities are publicized closer to the time of the exhibit. The exhibit takes place at The Poydras Center, located at 500 W. Main Street, in New Roads, Louisiana. Hours are listed below:

First Weekend

Friday, June 4 6-9 pm (Reception TBA)
Saturday, June 5 10 am-5 pm
Sunday, June 6 10 am-2 pm

Second Weekend

Friday, June 11 10 am-5 pm
Saturday, June 12 10 am-5 pm
Sunday, June 13 10 am-2 pm

Artwork Categories:

- **Two-dimensional:** pieces created on a flat surface by painting, photography, printmaking, drawing, etc.
- **Three-dimensional:** sculptures created by shaping/combining metal, glass, wood, clay, textiles, polymers, found objects, etc.

General Guidelines: All artwork must be original. No piece previously exhibited in a Treasures exhibit will be accepted. Artists of all ages are welcomed. *Artwork must be exhibit-ready:* 2-D pieces must be framed or gallery wrapped, ready to hang, with fixtures attached. If there are any special exceptions, please make a note on the submission form. **Artists are responsible for insuring artwork.**

Number of Submissions: Each artist may submit one piece of 2-D and/or one piece of 3-D work. It is the exhibit committee's goal to have as many artists represented, as the facility will comfortably accommodate. A second piece in each category may be submitted with the understanding it is on a "space available" basis. Once all forms are received, the committee will decide if space is available. If so, second submissions listed on the entry form will be taken. If there is only room for some of the second submissions, a random drawing will determine which will be exhibited.

Sponsored Pieces: If you own an original artwork by another artist, you may sponsor it in the show. Indicate that it is a sponsored piece on the submission form. A registration fee is required. Priority will be given to artists' submission of their own work.

Submission Deadline: Submission forms must be received by **FRIDAY, APRIL 16, 2021** by email or mail. Forms postmarked on or before April 16, 2021 will be considered received by the submission deadline. **NO SUBMISSIONS will be accepted after this date.**

Registration Fees: The registration fee is \$15 for members and \$20 for non-members. Make checks payable to *Arts Council of Pointe Coupee*. **Artist registration fee must be paid with submission form. Registrations held over from 2020 will be applied to the 2021 exhibit.**

Art Intake: Artwork is received **Wednesday, May 12 12 p.m.-5 p.m.** or **Thursday, May 13, 9 am-4 pm** at the Poydras Center, 500 West Main, New Roads, LA. Exceptions are handled on a per request basis and must be made prior to the week of intake.

Artwork Sales: Artwork may be listed for sale. **Displayed artwork that is sold must remain in place throughout the duration of the exhibit to maintain the integrity of the show.** The ACPC facilitates transactions: no commission is charged. If a buyer uses a credit card, the ACPC will be reimbursed for credit card fees. Checks are mailed to selling artists after Treasures ends.

Arts Market: Participating artists may set up a table to display additional artwork for sale Saturday, June 5 or June 12 from 10 am-4 pm. Artists are responsible for handling sales transactions at this time. There is no additional charge to participate in the Arts Market.

Art Pick-Up: All artwork displayed in the Treasures exhibit must remain in place for the duration of the exhibit to maintain the integrity of the show. Art pick up is **Monday, June 21, 11am-7 pm.**

Additional Information: Participating artists are asked to assist the ACPC in holding a successful event. **Please consider donating an art piece for the Silent Auction;** proceeds support ACPC activities including Calling All Artists and Treasures events. There are also opportunities for involvement by assisting with the reception, workshops, greeting, etc. The ACPC will send information on volunteer opportunities once submissions are received. This event is **for you, the artist,** and we treasure your participation!
