June 2 – 4 and June 9 - 11, 2017

The eighth annual “Treasures of Pointe Coupee Art Exhibit” will take place at the Poydras Center located at 500 West Main Street, New Roads, Louisiana. This exhibit will open with a reception for participating artists and the community from 6:00 to 9:00 PM on June 2. The exhibit will be open between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 3 and June 10 and from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. on Sunday June 4 and June 11. We are currently planning various artist activities related to the exhibit and will be forwarding that information closer to the exhibit.

SUBMISSIONS: *All submission forms must be returned by Friday, 4/21/2017*

Each piece of artwork submitted must be original. No pieces that were exhibited during previous Treasures of Pointe Coupee Art Exhibits will be accepted for the 2017 exhibit. Artists may sell exhibited work. We are accepting two categories of artwork for the 2017 exhibit. Those categories are:

- **Two-dimensional works of art:** original pieces created on a flat surface including but not limited to photography, painting, printmaking, drawing, and/or bas relief.
- **Three-dimensional works of art:** original pieces created by shaping or combining hard materials such as stone, metal, wire, glass, or wood, or plastic materials such as clay, textiles, polymers, softer metals or found materials which may be worked by removal of material such as carving, or by assembly.

It is the exhibit committee’s goal to have as many artists represented in the exhibit as the facility space will comfortably accommodate. For that reason, each artist may submit one piece of original artwork in each category. You may submit a request to exhibit a second piece in each category on the attached form, but it is with the understanding it is on a “space available” basis. If we see we will have additional space, we will begin taking second submissions listed on the entry form. In the event that there is room for some, but not all of the second submissions to be exhibited, a random drawing will be held to determine which of the second submissions will be in the show.

DEADLINE: *The deadline for submitting submission forms is FRIDAY, APRIL 21, 2017.*

NO SUBMISSIONS TURNED IN AFTER THIS DATE WILL BE ACCEPTED.

ARTISTS: *The exhibit is designed to celebrate and showcase local and regional artists. There will be a \$15 registration fee for each artist. Artists who are members of the Arts Council of Pointe Coupee will pay a \$ 12 registration fee. For information about membership levels, please contact Gale Roy (contact info below). Checks can be made payable to Arts Council of Pointe Coupee. A “Best in Show” award will again be presented.*

Entry Information

- **Artwork must be exhibit ready:** Two dimensional works must be framed or gallery wrapped, ready to hang with fixtures attached for such hanging. If there are any special exceptions or needs, please let us know.
- **Art Intake:** Each artist is responsible for dropping off their work between Monday, May 29 from noon - 5 p.m. and Tuesday, May 30 between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. at the first floor of the Poydras Center at 500 West Main, New Roads. Exceptions will be handled on a per request basis and must be made prior to the week of intake.
- **Art Pick-up:** Each Artist is responsible for picking up his / her work on Sunday, June 11, between 2 p.m. and 4 p.m.
- **Number of Submissions:** Each artist may submit one piece of two-dimensional artwork and /or one piece of three-dimensional work from their collection. If interested in submitting a second piece in either category, complete a second form. [Once we have received all submissions, the committee will decide if there will be space available for second submissions.] Please use one form for each piece of artwork being submitted.
- **Gallery Display:** All artwork displayed in the Treasures exhibit, **including any artwork that is sold**, will remain in place throughout the duration of the exhibit to maintain the integrity of the entire show.

Submission Deadline: Submission forms and entry fee (see page 1) must be submitted by Friday, 4/21/2017.

(Entry fee is per artist, not per piece)

Frequently Asked Questions

Will my artwork be accepted?

All artwork will be accepted if the definitions and guidelines of Treasures of Pointe Coupee stated above are followed.

What is required for submission?

You must return the Submission Form(s) by Friday, **April 21, 2017** either by email or mail to insure a place in the show. Submission Forms sent by mail with a postmark dated on or before April 21, 2017 will be considered to have been received by the submission deadline. Any submissions received after this date will not be accepted. **Artist registration fee must be paid with submission forms.**

What if I cannot drop off the artwork at the designated times?

What else is required of me as a participating artist?

We would ask that you volunteer to assist us in putting on a very well planned and exhibited event. There are many opportunities for involvement and support: volunteers to assist with publicity, refreshments, monitoring exhibit... **Artists are asked to consider donating a piece of artwork for the Silent Auction on Friday, June 2.** Proceeds from the Silent Auction will be used to support future activities of the Arts Council, including Calling All Artists and Treasures of Pointe Coupee events. We truly need your help to insure this event runs smoothly. This evening is **for you, the artist**, and we want your input too.

Can I sponsor another artist's works in this exhibit?

Yes. If you own a piece of original artwork by another artist, you may sponsor the work in the show. Complete a submission form. Please state that you are a sponsor on the name field; a registration fee is required. Priority will be given to artists' submission of their own work.

Will we be able to sell our artwork?

Yes. The purpose of the exhibit is to promote our artists socially and commercially. Please be prepared to network! Having contact information such as business cards may be helpful to you. **Artwork displayed in the Treasures exhibit that is sold will remain in place throughout the duration of the exhibit to maintain the integrity of the entire show.** Artists will be provided the opportunity to sell additional artwork on Saturday, June 3 and June 10 during the hours of the exhibit.
